After getting acquainted with this vibrant city, you can opt to spend the remainder of your day at leisure or take an optional tour of the meticulously landscaped grounds and soaring fountains of the Peterhof Grand Palace,*** better known as the "Russian Versailles." Tonight, delight in traditional Georgian cuisine at a favorite local restaurant. Savor the exotic comfort food and drink of a region that has been producing wine for over 8,000 years. (B, D)

rebuilt six times to satisfy the grand visions of Peter the Great's daughter, Elizabeth. Enjoy exclusive early access here and marvel at the robin's egg blue exterior and the lavish décor of the interior rooms. Next, we'll see St. Petersburg from a different perspective - from the interior of a vintage Soviet car! Feel as if you've entered a different era as you ride through the city in luxury. Tonight, get one final taste of Russian culture and cuisine during a farewell dinner and traditional folk show. (*B*, *D*)

Day 9: Friday, April 29, 2022 St. Petersburg - Tour Ends Today, say *do-svidaniya* (goodbye for now) to Russia as your Imperial journey comes to a close. (*B*)

Experience It! The Hermitage

A treasure trove for art lovers and historians alike, the Hermitage is one of the most impressive and expansive museums in the world. The museum started out as the personal collection of Catherine the Great, a royal known for her love of art and finer things. It's said that the museum was derived from the term "hermitage," a dwelling of a recluse, to denote the exclusivity of access to the museum. Eventually, the museum was opened to the public by Nicholas I in 1852. Today, the Hermitage's complex spans across five linked buildings and features over 3 million artworks and artifacts ranging in history from ancient Egypt to early 20th-century Europe. Uncover some of the world's finest masterpieces while being transported to Imperial Russia on a guided tour of this spellbinding museum.

Passports and visas are required for this tour at your expense. Certain countries require a minimum of 6 months passport validity from date of return home. Additional fees may apply.

To complete your tour, we <u>include</u> roundtrip airport-to-hotel transfers when purchasing our airfare with your tour. If you have arranged for your <u>own air</u>, we are pleased to provide you the option of *purchasing* these transfers. Please note that all transfers will leave at pre-scheduled times.

Single accommodations are limited and are available on a first come, first served basis.

*When the Assumption Cathedral is not available, we will visit either the Cathedral of the Annunciation or the Cathedral of the Archangel.

**Red Square may be closed/blocked at any time.

***During the months that the Peterhof fountains are unavailable, a tour of the palace will be available with this option.

The overall activity level of this tour is a level 4. This means you're ready to seize the day, whatever it may bring. You lead an active life at home (walking, biking, and hiking are things you may enjoy) and few thousand steps a day isn't out of the norm. You can handle longer walking tours (more than 90 minutes), traversing dusty or uneven terrain, standing for periods of time, varying altitudes and temperatures, and don't mind being on the go with some early starts, late-night experiences, and full days. Unfortunately, this level is not appropriate for individuals who use wheelchairs or walkers.
