

Michael A. Mordenga Bio

Born and raised in Rochester, Michael has made his home in Greece since 1966. Michael grew up with his mom Rose Mary, his dad Philip and his two younger brothers Anthony and Samuel. Michael participated in most sports while growing up, however he is best known for his achievements in gymnastics. As a former gymnast from Greece Arcadia High School where he earned Monroe County, Section V and All-American honors. In addition to sports and academics, Michael grew up actively involved with his dad in Scouting. Michael became an Eagle Scout at the age of 13.

Michael graduated from Greece Arcadia High School in 1975. He went on to become a gymnast and football cheerleader at the University of Michigan. Michael was named team captain of the squad from 1978 – 1979. Michael is a 1979 graduate of the University of Michigan and member of the U of M Alumni Cheerleaders Association. Michael joined the Eastman Kodak Company following graduation in 1979. He held many positions in Film and Paper Manufacturing over his 17 year career at Kodak. Michael was appointed the Worldwide Packaging Manager for the Single Use Camera Business in 1994. Feeling the need to move on, Michael left Kodak in 1996 to become the Technical Director at Diamond Packaging. Michael was appointed the Vice President and General Manager of Casco Security Systems in 1997.

In fulfillment of a life long dream Michael founded The Victors Gymnastics and Cheerleading Training Center in 1999. He is the current owner, President and CEO of The Victors Gymnastics, Inc. which he established in 2003 and Managing Member of The Victors Gymnastics and Cheerleading Training Center, LLC. Michael was named the gymnastics coach for the Greece Athena Varsity Cheerleaders from 1996 – 1999, leading Athena to a first-place finish in Section V in 1999 and first runner-up honors in the Large Varsity Division at the 1999 American Open Nationals. In 2002 he assisted the Brockport High School Varsity Co-ed Cheerleaders to a second-place finish at Section V, a first-place finish at Greater Rochester, and a first runner-up finish at ECA National Finals.

In 2009 Michael was named head coach of the Greece Varsity High School Gymnastics Team. In his first year as head coach Michael led the team to their first ever Monroe County and Section V Championships. He was named 2009 High School Gymnastics Coach of the Year. In addition to Greece, Michael coached the Webster and Hilton High School Varsity Gymnastics teams in 2010 and 2011.
